Harlow Group is primarily engaged in the design, preservative treatment, painting, manufacture, storage, sales and distribution of timber, panels, products, engineered timber products, timber frame and prefabricated timber buildings parts.

Harlow Group is committed to the protection of the environment, including prevention of pollution, and meeting our compliance obligations and to the promotion of wood as a renewable and environmentally friendly material. This policy is reviewed annually however, the impact of our operations on the environment is continually appraised and our environmental programme is geared to promoting consistent continual improvement.

Harlow Group will:

- Ensure that as far as possible, all timber purchases are from well managed forests and wherever possible this is endorsed by verifiable evidence or certification. To this end Harlow Group is making positive moves towards stocking products from legal, sustainable, and well managed forests and in particular FSC® and PEFC™ certified products. The Company has achieved FSC® and PEFC of custody certification.
- Comply with timber legal requirements and such as EUTR and TTF Responsible Purchasing Policy.

- Communicate this policy to all persons who work in, and on behalf of Harlow Group, making this policy available to the public and other interested parties through our website.
